Footnotes

UNHINGED, in midpack early, closed up and stalked the pace on the turn, angled out four-wide approaching the stretch, swept by the leader upper stretch and held sway under intermittent urging. WHAT SAY YOU raced off the pace, closed gradually four-wide through the turn then finished all out. MATHURA raced off the pace, came two and three-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch and rallied belatedly. ARCHESS, in range, was hustled two-wide late turn then finished evenly. DURINGANDAFTER, in touch, chased three to five-wide on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch, was game but not a threat. U SO LUCKY led early, set a pressured pace, shook clear on the turn, was passed upper stretch and tired. MOLINARO RAPIDA was up close early and pressed the pace, was roused at the top of the stretch but showed no response. FELICITY raced midpack between horses, faded under a ride on the turn.
