GAZUMBA settled off the pace, closed two-wide late turn, took the lead upper stretch, entertained a challenge from PRIZED HUMOUR, turned that one back prevailing under a drive. PRIZED HUMOUR, in range, stalked on the turn, chased six-wide into the stretch, bid near midstretch, vied briefly but failed to match strides with the winner while clearly best of the rest. ROYAL RAGE raced midpack, was blocked at the top of the stretch then finished all out when clear. HARVEST HOME raced midpack, closed seven-wide into the stretch, was game but evened out late. COGNASHENE raced off the pace, closed along the rail into the stretch, was blocked then tendered a mild rally between horses. SLEW THE MAESTRO raced off the pace, was roused five-wide

upper stretch but never reached contention. BRENNER PASS, well back early, saved ground, angled out through the stretch, finished gamely but was not a threat. MILLENNIUM LAKES raced midpack, angled from the rail to the sixth path on the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out. PREFERRED ISSUE dueled between horses but tired upper stretch. BRISTOL INDIAN, in range along the rail, angled out late turn, was roused and got up close near the 13/16ths pole but tired. RAVEN STONE dueled outside two others, drifted out slightly at the top of the stretch and tired. MR FULLER dueled along the rail then tired upper stretch. REGAL IMPRESSION vied briefly and dropped out of the duel, was in range to the turn then faded gradually. SOUL SEEKER raced midpack early but faded from early turn.
