Footnotes

PERFECT AFLEET stalked the pace, bid five-wide late turn, drew clear upper stretch and widened under a hand ride. JUSTIN'S TAPIT led early, was joined near the far turn, dueled, was headed upper stretch and chased to the end. MAVERICK MAN raced off the pace, closed late turn, was hustled into the stretch then rallied in vain. JOJO'S MOJO stalked the pace, chased along the rail on the far turn then evened out in the final 16th. I WANT YOU TO KNOW stalked the pace, bid early on the far turn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired. WHIPPIT, in range, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. OBAN settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn but never reached contention. GHOST TIME raced midpack, chased four-wide late turn then tired in the final 16th. POWERMAN, rated in midpack, was five-wide throughout and tired midstretch.
