Footnotes

SUMMA SAMARA was 5 wide in the first turn, stalked the pace in the backstretch off the rail, roused around the 2nd turn and was full of run in the drive from the four path, assumed command with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. SKYLIGHT SERENADE pressed the early pace 3 wide, assumed command in the 2nd turn, but was no match for the winner. CALL ME ANNIE was fanned 5 wide around the first turn, raced close up outside of rivals in the backstretch, then weakened in the drive. T. J. MAGIC set a pressured pace between horses, weakened in the 2nd turn and dropped back. GREAT GAZOO was void of early speed, raced 3 wide in the 2nd turn and finished evenly. ASCOT BELLE was close up between horses, but failed to respond. INDECENT THOUGHTS was void of early speed between horses, never rallied and was never a factor. ON WINGS OF EAGLES stalked the early pace between horses, then faded in the 2nd turn. STORMY ALEXIS was void of early speed 3 wide and outrun. GREYORGRAY was hustled along and pressed the pace along the rail, then faded in the 2nd turn.
