PERFECT BULLET raced five-wide into the first turn then settled midpack, closed three-wide moving out to the fifth path on the far turn then rallied determinedly and got up late under a drive. TIGER BUD moved off the rail quickly and pressed the pace two-wide, dueled on the backstretch then edged clear late turn, was all out and drifted out a bit in the stretch but failed to contain the winner in the late stages. ALEZZANDRO raced midpack, was hustled four-wide into the stretch then finished all out. CHAPLAIN, rated early, closed moving from the third path to six-wide on the far turn, was game in the stretch but evened out late. TAP SHOW, well back early, angled from the rail to four-wide late on the far turn then rallied mildly. BOLD FINISH stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn but flattened out in the final furlong. FORTY CREEK, unhurried early, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. OMAGGIO led quickly, set a pressured pace, was engaged early backstretch, dueled to the turn, was headed and chased the leader to the stretch and tired. STOLONBOY stalked the pace, dropped back late backstretch and was roused, was hustled through the turn and tired.
