KNOWN TENDER stalked the forced pace four wide, wore down MR. EPPERSON three wide in the stretch. MR. EPPERSON had speed to clear early, set a pressured pace off the rail, gave up the lead briefly on the turn, regained the lead late on the turn, gave his best in the stretch. TACKY AFFAIR stalked the forced pace from the inside, finished well three wide. VOBISCUM stalked the forced pace three wide. SUMMERSVILLE trailed, was three wide on the turn, passed tiring rivals. BRUSHING BULLY stalked the forced pace from off the rail, dropped back. LAKEFIELD pressed the pace inside the winner, gained a short lead going into the turn, gave way, and was pulled up.
