CHRIS'S BAD BOY stalked the pace three wide, gained command in mid stretch and drew off. PRINCE MONTY had speed to clear while off the rail, gave way in mid stretch to be second best. HUNTING THE GOLD was three wide while between horses, rallied mildly four wide. COLEBROOK RUCKUS stalked the pace from off the rail. EXPECTED FLIRT trailed while four wide, passed tiring rivals. TANK'S EXPECTATION was inside, and not a threat. BELIEVER'S LUCKY raced four wide, showed little. REGAL SAHIB was inside, and faded.
