POETIC CAT broke alertly then settled, closed on the turn, took the lead near the top of the stretch and widened under steady pressure. WATHS UP PATRICK raced off the pace, came six-wide into the stretch and rallied in vain. SERVICE ACT raced midpack, was under a steady hustle late turn and finished all out. DOUBLE NAUGHT SPY raced midpack, closed four-wide late turn but failed to menace. SOUL BROTHER raced midpack, came five and

six-wide through the turn and finished determinedly in vain. MANDERLAY raced off the pace, was hustled seven-wide into the stretch and tired. NORTHERN GENERAL, well back early, angled from the fourth path to the eighth path through the turn then evened out in the stretch. HOT PROPOSITION raced midpack, came two and three-wide through the turn and lacked a rally. FLASHY J R chased on the backstretch and turn, angled two-wide to four-wide through the turn then tired in the stretch. DANIAL S, off a step slowly, was hustled two-wide through the turn then passed tiring horses. CATCH THE POSSE sprinted clear early backstretch, set the pace, was collared late turn and tired. JUST TRIPPINALONG raced midpack, angled from the rail to seven-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. I'M THE MANAGER, well back early, angled in from the fourth path to the second path late turn then lacked a rally. GOING REGIMENTAL raced off the pace, saved ground but lacked a closing response.
