Footnotes

AWESOME DEED was slow early well off the rail, roused five wide on the turn and closed with a rush in the drive getting up in the final strides. QUEEN OF THE BLUES stalked the early pace inside of rivals, saved ground throughout and slipped through in mid stretch getting up for place. HOPE'S HOPE pressed the early pace from the inside, assumed command on the turn and opened a length lead in the drive, but failed to sustain the bid. PEMBROKE LASS raced close up between horses, entered the stretch three wide and finished well. SEA WAY LADY pressed the early pace three wide, then tired in the stretch. HERECOMESROBIN was void of early speed off the rail, went four wide on the turn, but never rallied. ARCTIC MISS stalked the early pace from well off the rail and never rallied. KILLALY was hustled along pressing the early pace three wide, then tired. MISS ICICLE was void of early speed and outrun.
