Footnotes

CHOPININA set the early pace in hand inside of rivals, opened a length advantage on the turn, then drew clear in the drive under intermittent urging. HOLLYWOOD ENDING was unhurried early while saving ground, roused entering the stretch and moved off the rail in the drive, finished well but was no match for the winner. CRYSTAL HARMONY pressed the early pace three wide, then dropped back on the turn and saved ground, moved outside of the winner entering the stretch and closed the gap, but weakened in the late going. BAR U MOKWA was void of early speed, roused three wide on the turn and rallied belatedly. HASTY KISS was unhurried early inside of rivals, made a mild bid in the stretch, but was never a threat. MY REAL QUIET LADY was void of early speed while saving ground, then passed tiring rivals in the drive. NIGHT EDITION was unhurried early in the middle of the pack and never rallied. TOPSY MORNING (IRE) pressed the early pace between horses, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. RARE VISION was unhurried early, roused three wide on the turn, but never rallied and was never a threat. EMILYNA was close up outside of rivals and lacked a late response. MISS BENNY showed little. CLASSIC BIRD was void of early speed in the three path and never a factor.
