Footnotes

LOUIS duled on the backstretch, gained a short lead on the turn, was clear approaching the stretch then held under steady handling. HATCHET forced the pace, chased through the stretch and was gaining late. IDEALS AND DREAMS raced up close, chased four and five-wide on the turn and finished gamely. FRIDAY NIGHT GUY, away alertly, settled midpack, was hustled five and six-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. DOC FROST raced off the pace, came two and three-wide through the turn, chased hard into the stretch, angled out a bit and rallied belatedly. DIABLO NEGRO, up close early, chased three and four-wide on the turn then flattened out in deep stretch. JAIMOE settled off the pace, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but failed to menace. I'M A LUMBERJACK raced midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn then evened out midstretch. KACHOW, in range while racing four

and five-wide, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. JEST A GENIUS raced midpack, saved ground, was roused at the top of the stretch then finished evenly along the rail. BRITE SAMMY dueled, yielded late backstretch, dropped back a little on the turn, still chased to the stretch then flattened out. SPANISH PLAYBOY raced midpack, was hustled five-wide late turn then tired in the stretch. SHORTMAN, off slowly, trailed the field and lacked a closing response.
