### Footnotes

SPIRIT WARNINGS stalked the pace from between horses, chased into the stretch, responded smartly and swept by the pacesetter a furlong out and drew clear under a light drive. RISING DOUGH, in range at the rear of the pack, was hustled five and six-wide on the turn then finished willingly to no avail. ONE MORE DEAL had brief speed then pressed the pace through the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. TUXEDO RAY settled in range, stalked the pace, chased five-wide late turn but evened out in deep stretch. SEVEN DAY FOOL stalked the pace, chased late turn then flattened out along the rail. FINALLY TOGETHER dueled briefly then forced the pace into the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. BOLD HIPSTER dueled, held a short lead into the turn, set a pressured pace, was passed a furlong out and tired.
