CLEVER PEAKS, rated off the pace, angled out late turn, launched a strong bid in the final furlong and drove clear after a short duel. DANCE WITH GRETCH, in range, stalked to the stretch, was blocked briefly at the top of the stretch, found a path out between foes and quickly launched a challenge but was outkicked. MOONGODDESS, in touch, chased hard late turn, angled out then launched an all out charge. BURMAH STAR, squeezed back early, raced in touch with the leader, bid late on the far turn, dueled into the stretch, was headed a 16th out and gave way. HASTETOTHEWEDDING forced the early pace, dropped back late turn then came up with a mild but late response. SAVETHETHOUGHT set a pressured pace, quickened on the turn, was joined late turn, dueled, then tired in the final furlong. SUMMER ENDING stalked the pace, bid along the rail late turn, dueled, but tired in the final furlong. TABANKA pressed the pace, tendered a brief bid late turn then tired upper stretch.
