Footnotes

D'S PERFECT SOUL stalked the pace from the rail, closed between foes upper stretch, bid a 16th out and was all out to prevail. BEST BARD raced in midpack, closed five-wide late turn, launched an all out drive, bid a 16th out, dueled but was outfinished. CANADIAN FLAG raced in midpack, chased into the stretch and finished under a determined drive . IMPETUOUS ACT, in midpack early, angled out late turn, finished gamely and was gaining late. JASPER'S POSSE, well back early, closed into the stretch, was involved in a barrage of bumping upper stretch but finished gamely. ONETWOPUNCH, in range early along the rail, bumped with rivals upper stretch and a furlong out then finished gamely . FLORIDA BEAR stalked the pace, chased into the stretch but tired midstretch. GOOD ANSWER raced in midpack, chased hard into the stretch, was all out to the final 16th then flattened out. WHISPER PLEASE raced off the pace, closed into the stretch, was part of the bumping upper stretch and evened out. FIRST CHAPTER raced in midpack, backed away early turn, saved ground but was never in contention . OHTHGIFT settled off the pace, chased into the stretch, was bumped hard upper stretch and was through. BIG SHOOTER stalked the pace, chased three-wide into the stretch then tired midstretch . NOLO got away a bit slowly but moved up the rail to take command midway through the backstretch, shook clear on the turn, set the pace, was passed upper stretch and tired. ORION'S SONG raced off the pace, came three-wide through the turn and lacked a rally.
