PEAKS OR VALLEYS was allowed to settle inside of rivals just off the rail, angled out midway through the turn, came three wide in the drive and wore down rivals under strong urging. UPBEAT stalked the early pace from off the rail, drew even entering the backstretch and dueled outside of CHARMING MELODY, put that one away in the drive, but could not hold off the winner. The latter stalked the pace entering the first turn, moved to the front and dueled inside of UPBEAT to deep stretch, but weakened in the late going. CAMPAIGN ANDOVER was close up three wide and lacked a late response. NIGHT EDITION was slow early off the rail, roused in the backstretch and made a mild bid in the drive, but was never a threat. CROWN'S SHADOW sprinted to the early lead, but gave way entering the backstretch and dropped back in the drive. ALLEYNEDALE was unhurried early and never rallied. PHONE DANCER was void of early speed three wide and never rallied.
