Footnotes

DON'T LOOK NOW stalked the pace, closed on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch, took command and drove clear. VICTORIAN DAMASK led early, set a reserved pace, was engaged at the top of the stretch and was no match for the winner but held the place. FEELING NAUGHTY stalked three-wide, was hustled late turn and was all out through the stretch. STRIKE THE HARP, off a step slowly, saved ground, was roused upper stretch and finished gamely. CHRISTINE'S PRIZE, in touch early, was hustled along the second path then hung in the stretch. KATERI raced three-wide from well off the pace and was never in contention. PANAMA ANA, also well back throughout, raced four-wide and lacked a closing response. BARBS AND BOWS showed brief speed from the gate, settled quickly, raced midpack three-wide and lacked a rally. BELLA CORONA raced on the rail but was always outrun.
