RIO BAY raced in midpack, closed four and five-wide on the turn, lodged a bid upper stretch and drove clear then was taken well in hand in the late stages. NARRATE stalked the pace, chased up close four-wide on the turn, failed with a bid upper stretch but chased gamely to the end. WILD STRIKE stumbled at the start, recovered quickly and took command, set a pressured pace, angled out through the turn, was headed upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. QUEEN OF BANDINI settled off the pace, closed five-wide late turn but never reached contention. TREVI FOUNTAIN raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out. CORAL SANDS showed brief speed, chased on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. HARLEM PRINCESS, steadied slightly at the start, took a run at the leader but quickly dropped back to stalk, chased along the rail on the turn then evened out in the final furlong.
