MATTER OF TRUTH forced the pace, chased into the stretch, bid a 16th out and wore down his rival in the late stages. SILO RIDGE showed speed, set a pressured pace, was engaged midstretch and gave way grudgingly. TAKEMBAKTOARTEMUS in range early, chased into the stretch, finished under a determined drive and missed. NO EXCHANGES raced in midpack, closed into the turn, chased to the stretch and finished willingly. BILBY RHODE stalked

early, was hustled late turn and finished gamely along the rail. BELL'S FIRST LAD settled off the pace, closed late turn, chased six-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. STRIKE OIL close early, was squeezed back at the turn, chased to the stretch but failed to menace. BEAR'S ACCOUNTANT stalked the pace, chased on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. POLITICAL REBEL stalked the pace on the backstretch, chased four-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. ROYAL FIGHTER stalked the early pace, saved ground but tired in the stretch. SUTTER'S FIND , taken well back early while rank, closed late turn then evened out in the stretch. BEN'S BEST BET stalked to midturn, dropped back then lacked a rally. REAL HERO settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn then tired in the stretch.
