BERT'S BAR, close early, bid along the rail into the turn, gained a short lead, was set down at the top of the stretch and widened to finish under a hand ride. STORMY REVENGE, bothered at the start, settled off the pace, angled out late turn and was all out through the stretch. AIR BLADE raced off the pace, was hustled late turn, chased five-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. DOWNTOWN settled off the pace, chased five-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. DAWNSCAPE broke outward, gained the lead and set a pressured pace, was joined midway through the backstretch, dueled briefly, chased on the turn then evened out in the stretch. ZOL ZAYNE forced the pace, dueled from mid backstretch, was headed and forced the issue on the turn then tired midstretch. GLOBAL EXPRESS, in touch, chased hard on the turn then lacked a closing response. GOLDEN RIVET broke outward, settled off the pace, was hustled late turn but flattened out in the stretch. PERFECT YEAR settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn then lacked a closing response. MAJOR IRONSIDES forced the pace, was squeezed back at the turn, chased to the stretch and tired.
