WHO'S MR. HUGHES raced forwardly, was joined in earnest midway through the far turn, drove clear upper stretch and held sway under steady pressure. MATTANGEL, rated off the pace, closed along the rail through the far turn, angled three-wide at the top of the stretch and finished all out. NERVE CENTER, squeezed back at the start, settled off the pace, closed inside rivals on the far turn, angled out a bit at the top of the stretch and finished under a determined drive. PALAMINO ANTONIO stalked the pace, chased on the far turn then finished evenly. PRE LAW stalked the pace, bid midway of the far turn, dueled, was cleared by his rival upper stretch and tired. DRY RUN raced in midpack, chased five-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. LACROSSE stalked the pace, chased hard four-wide on the far turn then tired in the final furlong. RESAMA broke inward, raced in striking range to the far turn and tired. SHOT MAKER dueled, gained a slight advantage and set a pressured pace on the backstretch, was headed at the turn and faded.
