### Footnotes

SPEIGHTSTOWN sprinted to an early unchallenged lead, moved to the rail and set the pace under a good hold, roused in the drive and prevailed without being hit. BRIDGEPORT stalked the early pace from the two path, roused on the turn three wide and finished well, but was no match for the winner. JET DRIVE chased the winner from the rail, then weakened in the stretch. A GENUINE HONOUR was close up three wide in the early going, then weakened in the drive. SAMBUCA ON ICE was allowed to settle off the rail, roused five wide on the turn and made a mild bid, but flattened out in the drive. MIGWAKI was void of early speed in the three path, never rallied and was never a threat. CLASSIC BIRD showed little and was outrun.
