STUCK IN TRAFFIC broke outward, closed four-wide into the turn, drew off and held sway driving upper stretch and in hand late. JUSTCALLMEABANDIT raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn and rallied gamely. FIVE AND OFF, close early, vied into the turn then chased three-wide but evened out in deep stretch. CUPID'S CONTRACT had speed to get the lead, vied into the turn, chased along the rail then evened out. CIANO NIGHTS, well back early, saved ground and rallied mildly. KINCAREY raced off the pace, was roused early turn then hustled three-wide but was not a threat. MR. TIP, close early, chased between rivals on the turn then hung in the stretch. WILBERFORCE, prominent early, chased two-deep on the turn then flattened out. EL CAMINO ROYALE was hustled from the outset and was close early along the rail, gave way late turn and flattened out. TOBAR was always far back on the second path and lacked a rally.
