### Footnotes

QWEST FIELD stalked the leaders then bid outside the front runner in the drive and proved much the best in the final furlong. REGALLY READY chased the speed, then pressed and bid outside, led into the stretch but was not able to match the winner in the final furlong. HALTON GULLY was off a step slow, gained off the rail then had a mild stretch try to best the others. HARLEM HUSTLER was off a step slow, chased the leaders then backed off on the turn and tired through the stretch. POWER MOVE off the pace and then inside for the stretch run, failed to menace. LE MIEUX was well back throughout and never a factor. BLONDESSILVERDREAM broke outwards then showed speed to lead into the turn, was pressured and faded on the rail. EYES TO RULE broke slow, was never in it and then outdistanced.
