IMPERIAL'S BEST led early, set a reserved pace, quickened on the far turn then held sway under a steady drive. QUEENSBURY RULES stalked the pace, chased angling from the rail to five-wide on the far turn and was all out through the stretch. GANADAR raced off the pace, was hustled six-wide late turn, finished well but did not menace. NORTE AND NICE steadied just out, raced off the pace, was hustled three to seven-wide on the far turn then rallied belatedly. TRAJECTAMAX stalked the pace, chased three to six-wide on the far turn then evened out in the late stages. RINK RAT, off a step slowly, settled well back, was hustled on the far turn but was not a threat. GOLD EIRE raced midpack, chased two to five-wide on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. RAIN DANCE, rated off the pace, angled from the rail to three-wide late turn but lacked a closing response. NEAR EXPECTATIONS, in range, chased late turn, came six-wide into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. EXCELLENCY, in range early, settled midpack, was roused midturn but tired in the stretch.
