DANGER BAY stalked the pace, launched his drive upper stretch, bid midstretch and edged clear under a drive. MIAMI DECO raced in midpack, closed four-wide late turn, chased hard into the stretch, finished all out and was just up for the place. DIAMONSDIPLOMAT led quickly, set a reserved pace, was engaged midstretch and yielded grudgingly. ACTION PLAN raced off the pace, angled off the rail late turn then finished all out. BOWMAN'S CAUSEWAY, well back early, saved ground then posted a mild rally outside. DUBAI ECHO, in range, chased three-wide into the stretch, launched a determined drive but evened out late. APRES MIDI raced well back, saved ground but never reached contention. BEAR'S TAURUS, in range along the rail, was hustled late turn then flattened out in the final furlong. SHANGHAI KNIGHT settled off the pace, chased late turn then tired in the stretch.
