IRISH MISSION stalked the pace, closed late backstretch and lapped onto the leader, forced the issue to the stretch, bid a furlong out, gained a short lead and held under a drive. NORTHERN PASSION raced in midpack, chased late turn, angled out sharply at the top of the stretch and rallied outside. AWESOME FIRE settled off the pace, chased on the far turn then finished all out. BLACK BIRD ROCK led quickly, set a reserved pace, quickened on the turn while being pressured, was engaged a furlong out and gave way. DIXIE STRIKE raced in midpack, closed into the far turn, stalked the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. WAITINGINTHEWINGS stalked the pace, chased late turn and flattened out in the stretch. ROSE AND SHINE raced in midpack, was roused through the far turn and tired in the stretch. HORSESHOE HILL forced the pace, chased from the rail on the far turn then tired at the top of the stretch. BANTEE broke in the air, settled off the pace, was hustled on the far turn and tired in the stretch.
