SOPHIA'S PRINCE just off the pace, closed 3-wide and dueled from there into the stretch, kept in the tussle into the final sixteenth then was all out to save the place spot. GANGSTER off the rail and trailing into the turn, cut to the rail for the drive, rallied willingly and was going well late. CHRIS'S BAD BOY dueled inside of rivals and kept in the game through the turn and into the furlong pole then gave way from off the rail. SIR BLITZ stalked the pace battle from the rail and had a good trip but lacked a stretch rally.
