MYSTERIOUS AFFAIR vied for the early lead 3 wide, dueled in the three path around the turn with LATER YEARS, put that one away in upper stretch and drew clear under constant handling. PROMISING WEST was void of early speed outside of rivals and stayed wide through the turn, lugged in in the stretch, but finished well getting up for place. LATER YEARS was hustled along between horses, dueled just off the rail around the turn, but weakened in the drive. MEMA'S TURNING RED was in the second flight along the rail, angled out midway through the turn, but lacked a late response. GOLDEN PATH was hustled along and pressed the early pace along the rail, weakened and dropped back around the turn. SOUTHERN SANDRA was hustled along 4 wide and never a factor. LILIES HALO was washy in the post parade, raced close up in the backstretch just off the rail, saved ground through the turn, but dropped back in the drive.
