Footnotes

EXPECT A MINT stalked the early pace from just off the rail, closed the gap on the turn then assumed command entering the stretch and drew clear under intermittent urging. TRICKY MOMENT was in hand between horses stalking the early pace, roused with left handed urging on the turn and got up for place. EXPLOSIVE AMY was void of early speed, rallied four wide on the turn and finished well. ONCE UPON A TWINE was void of early speed three wide, roused between horses on the turn, angled to the rail in the drive and rallied belatedly. CRIMSON COURTIER set the early pace in hand and unchallenged, then faltered entering the stretch and dropped back. CABRI stalked the early pace between horses, but failed to respond and dropped back in the drive. REDCARPETTREATMENT was off slowly, but quickly closed the gap along the rail and stalked the early pace, then got tired in the stretch and dropped back. FRESH STRIKE was close up between horses and dropped back to last on the turn.
