NOT FOR ROYALS stalked the pace, angled from four-wide to six-wide on the turn, rallied gamely and took the lead midstretch, drove clear then held under steady pressure. A P VALOR raced midpack, came five and six-wide through the turn, rallied gamely and was gaining late. I'M NO PREACHER raced midpack four and five-wide then rallied late between foes. BRAVE SPIRIT settled off the pace, came five and six-wide through the turn and rallied from far back at the top of the stretch. WILBERFORCE dueled, gained a short lead on the turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was passed midstretch and gave way. COLONEL BE GOOD dueled, dropped back a bit but remained in striking position on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out. KWIK COSTA, close early, bid two-deep into the turn, forced the pace then tired midstretch. POINT TUPPER was hustled from off the pace on the turn, rallied mildly between horses but did not threaten. SOIR NOIR settled off the pace, angled from the third path to seven-wide closing on the turn but never reached contention. ZAP IT stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. GOLDY SONG dueled, forced the pace on the turn then tired in the final furlong. QUINNER'S CIRCLE raced midpack along the rail then lacked a rally. CLASS AX raced midpack three and four-wide, was hustled late turn then evened out in the stretch.
