Footnotes

NAFTA stalked the pace three-wide, chased into the stretch, lodged his bid a furlong out and drove clear. LOOKS PURRRFECT settled off the pace, closed then circled late turn, came six-wide into the stretch, chased determinedly but evened out late. HEY BATTER BATTER forced the pace, stalked on the turn, bid between foes a furlong out but was outkicked. WHISPERED LEGEND raced off the pace, closed three to five-wide on the turn, was all out in the stretch but failed to threaten. RUNAWAY MY WAY took command on the backstretch, set a pressured pace , dueled on the turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was caught a furlong out, chased briefly and tired. ASK THE BESTMAN, away alertly, was headed moving on to the main track, forced the pace, bid and dueled through the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased to the final furlong and tired. WIGAMOG raced midpack, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. MECKE B KING raced midpack, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and tired.
