BENESTAR, away alertly, was headed but pressed the pacesetter, closed up into the turn and lapped on forcing the issue turn, bid in earnest upper stretch, drove clear then held under steady pressure. FIRETHEEXECUTIVE broke outward, stalked the pace still in hand through the turn, chased from the top of the stretch and finished gamely. ALWAYS WILDCATIN' raced off the pace, closed along the rail on the turn then finished willingly inside. DOCTOR JACK, in range, settled off the pace, angled three to six-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. BIG TIME, in range, chased four and five-wide on the turn but evened out in the late stages. PREAKNESS LAUGHER led early on the backstretch, set a pressured pace, was headed upper stretch and tired. BUG'S BOY raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. MAHONE BAY stalked the pace two and three-wide, was hustled late turn but tired at the top of the stretch. THE MAN UPTOWN dropped well back early, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. QWEST FIELD stalked the pace from the inside, chased into the stretch and tired.
