RILEY RIPASSO stalked the pace, saved ground, bid upper stretch and drove clear then held under steady pressure. TREND, in touch, stalked four and five-wide on the turn, came in upper stretch and bumped a rivals then finished gamely. VICAR STREET was prominent early, duelled from the rail on the turn, gained the lead at the top of the stretch, yielded a furlong out and tired. TIME TRIAL raced midpack, was hustled five-wide into the stretch, angled out and finished gamely. BLUEGRASS BEAR stalked the pace, was hustled five-wide into the stretch but lacked a closing response. DELAWANA, bumped at the start, kept in touch, chased into the stretch, finished all out but was not a threat. EAST POINT bumped with a rival at the start, stalked the pace, settled midpack on the turn, was checked when he lost his path, chased briefly and evened out in the stretch. ACTION PLAN raced off the pace, came four to six-wide through the turn, launched an all out drive then evened out in deep stretch. MODIMO showed speed between foes, gave way nearing the turn, faded gradually and had no further response. CHARLIE'S THE MAN closed late backstretch, bid into the turn, duelled, was headed upper stretch, was bumped then squeezed back and was through. ICE PILOT was prominent early, duelled on the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, was bumped and lacked a further response. AMIGA'S AMIGO settled well off the pace, trailed the field and lacked a rally.
