CHECK YOUR SOUL broke in the air, raced off the pace, closed four and five-wide on the far turn, took command upper stretch and drew off under a hand ride. BOWMAN'S CAUSEWAY raced midpack, chased four-wide on the far turn, bid at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner. STRIKE OIL, rated well back early, was hustled on the far turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch and finished gamely to no avail. HIPPOLYTUS raced off the pace, came three and four-wide through the far turn, chased into the stretch but failed to menace. SENSATIONAL SLAM stalked the pace, dropped back on the far turn and lacked a rally. IMHOTEP raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn then evened out in the final furlong. SANDY GULLY stalked the leader early, moved up and forced the pace on the backstretch, chased three-wide through the far turn then tired along the rail upper stretch. SPEED RING stalked the pace while saving ground, chased on the far turn then tired upper stretch. BEAR'S CHILL set a pressured pace, quickened on the far turn, was swarmed at the top of the stretch and tired.
