Footnotes

PERFECT SOUL (IRE) was off slowly and unhurried early just off the rail, swung wide on the turn and closed fast well off the rail assuming command and drawing off in the final strides. ANGEL'S SWEEP stalked the early pace inside of rivals, angled four wide in upper stretch and assumed command in mid stretch, but could not hold off the winner. PALACE CRUSADER was checked approaching the far turn and dropped back, saved ground on the turn, then angled out in the stretch and rallied belatedly. SLIM DUSTY bore out at the start and dropped back, angled to the rail and trailed well off the lead, entered the stretch in the three path, angled to the outside in the drive and closed willingly. JOHNNY HOLLYWOOD was allowed to settle in the middle of the pack three wide and ran evenly. NEEDHAM'S POINT stalked the early pace three wide, drew even on the turn, but failed to sustain the bid. CAREY THE TOOCH was unhurried early while saving ground, then passed tiring rivals in the stretch. CHIVAS ON ICE was hustled along close up between horses in the early going, then dropped back in the stretch. DUBAI SPECIAL was unhurried early three wide and lacked a late response. BUSY MAN vied for the early lead outside of ANGEL'S SWEEP, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. DESERT SCHOLAR was well rated pressing the early pace along the rail, then faltered in upper stretch and faded. SCOTTY'S BIG NITE bobbed at the start and ducked out, settled well off the lead and was outrun.
