Footnotes

FALWYN pressed the pace four wide, dueled outside the runner up on the turn, wore down that one in the stretch. SWINGING JANIE GAL had speed to clear early, dueled three wide outside of ONE FOR THE ANGELS and ALMENORA, shook off those two heading into the turn, and was challenged shortly afterwards by the winner, drifted in to the two path in mid stretch, gave her best. ONE FOR THE ANGELS came through to duel between horses, dropped back on the turn, came again in the stretch for show. VALID WIRE stalked the duel three wide while between horses, steadied mildly early on the turn, and was not a threat. TEXAS HEAT bumped at the start, stalked the duel from off the rail, evenly. MISS ELTISH stalked the duel five wide, and weakened. LIFE'S BLESSING was bumped between horses at the start, raced inside, passed tiring rivals three wide. ALMENORA dueled inside of ONE FOR THE ANGELS, gave way on the turn. BELIEVER'S QUEEN inside, showed little.
