WINTER GARDEN had speed from the start, took a short lead then drew clear at the 1/2 mile pole, set a reserved pace to the head of the stretch, was shown the whip several times then tapped twice in deep stretch and held with ears pricked. SPANISH DECREE closed up along the rail late on the backstretch, stalked on the turn then bid inside WINTER GARDEN at the 1/4 pole, could not stay with that one upper stretch but responded gamely and was gaining late. MISS SANTA ANITA trailed along the rail then rallied belatedly between foes. BIG CHEQUE showed speed from the gate but settled, stalked three-wide and closed up late turn then hung in the final furlong. RICH ASSERTION showed speed out of the gate then pressed the pacesetter from the third path, remained contentious to the top of the stretch and tired. TAMARA dropped back at the outset, remained unhurried then saved ground on the turn but failed to threaten. ROMAN ROMANCE raced four-wide into the turn, was roused and advanced mildly late turn then flattened out at the top of the stretch.
