BURNING BUSH, in range, closed late backstretch, stalked into the turn, chased into the stretch, bid a furlong out, dueled to the end and prevailed under a drive. BOOGIE BLUES broke slightly in the air and was allowed to race off the early pace, closed late backstretch, dueled between rivals on the turn, shook clear at the head of the stretch, was caught a furlong out, dueled to the wire and just missed. KINGS VILLAGE, unhurried early, was hustled late on the far turn, came six-wide into the stretch and rallied from last. BUY WITH GOLD, rated off the pace, closed into the far turn, was roused at the top of the stretch and launched an all out drive. BURANO, rated off the pace, closed late backstretch, was in touch on the turn, chased five-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. NOVEL FORCE stalked the pace, bid near the far turn, dueled from the third path, was header at the top of the stretch and tired after a brief chase. CAPOTE RULER broke alertly, set a reserved pace, dueled on the far turn, gave way late turn and tired.
