WELL WHOOPDEEDOO closed late backstretch, took command early turn and widened under a hand ride. STARFLIGHT LAD raced midpack, chased on the far turn but could not stay close in the stretch. ASHINGTON raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide then finished evenly without threatening. JUAN BAY B BULL raced midpack between horses, was all out in the stretch but did not threaten. CLASSY EXECUTIVE stalked the pace, saved ground, lacked a rally. ONE MORE DAY raced midpack between foes, never reached contention. VICTORIAN KNIGHT raced off the pace three-wide, lacked a rally. TRACY'S TINKER TOY broke in the air, trailed the field and passed a tiring horse. CRIMINALPERSUASION led quickly, set a reserved pace, was headed early on the far turn and tired badly.
