Footnotes

SAFETY ZONE raced midpack between horses, came five-wide into the stretch, gained steadily and got up late, driving. SAFE LANDING gained contention on the backstretch, stalked three-wide, launched an all out stretch drive, gained command for a step or two in the late stages but failed to contain the winner. RIVER HEIGHTS, up close early, bid late turn, led upper stretch then gave way in the late stages. IT'S LIKE THIS was well back early, saved ground, closed late turn, was determined in the stretch but hung. PRAIRIE FOX raced off the pace, came three-wide to the top of the stretch and tendered a mild run between rivals. SULTRY APPROVAL raced off the pace two-wide, was roused late turn and rallied mildly. COBRADOR raced midpack along the rail, closed late turn but lacked the needed stretch response. READ THE STARS, well back between horses, angled out upper stretch, was all out but never

threatened. HIGHVALE raced off the pace five-wide, raced seven-wide through the stretch, was all out but evened out late. EL GRAN JAKE stalked four-wide, lacked a rally and tired. POACHERS MOON raced midpack three-wide and was never in contention. VEGAS ANGEL led early, set a reserved pace but yielded at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and tired. SPECIAL TIGER, off a step slowly, raced well back but was never in contention. REDEPLOY was always well back.
