FLASHY GOT EVEN, well back early, was hustled into the stretch, angled out and closed a gap outside. WISEHER raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide into the stretch but lacked a strong late response. FIDDLESTICKS set the pace, was engaged late turn, vied into the stretch then yielded grudgingly. BOOM TOWN GAL raced midpack, was hustled four-wide into the stretch then flattened out late. RACE THE BREEZE raced off the pace, was hustled late turn, came six-wide into the stretch but needed more response. FLATT OUT LUCKY, off a step slowly, saved ground but lacked a serious rally. SILVER STING raced well back early, angled from the second to the sixth path late turn but never reached contention. JAZZLE DAZZLE 'EM raced off the pace, was hustled two-wide late turn then lacked a strong late response. PERFECT RESOLVE was taken well back early, continued to race off the pace, was steadied behind a rival late turn, angled out in the stretch but lacked a rally. SEDONA MISS, in range early, raced along the second path, was hustled on the turn then tired in the stretch.
