### Footnotes

TOO LATE NOW had the pace from off the rail, drew clear on the second turn when a rival broke down and moved inside, lasted until the wire under a drive. SEEKING THE RING stalked the forced pace three wide, finished well off the rail in the stretch. SANTERRA stalked the forced pace from off the rail, rallied late three wide to take the show position. BRATTOTHECORE raced four wide, gained late but was outfinished for show. KABUL stalked the forced pace from the inside, checked at the three eighths pole when avoiding a broken down rival, was not a threat. KISSED BY A PRINCE trailed early, advanced into the backstretch to be between horses, advanced mildly four wide on the second turn. MOUNTAIN DAWN well placed, inside. APPLEBY GARDENS was five to six wide throughout. MACDASHI was three wide on the first turn, raced four wide the rest of the way and did not threaten. BUFFALO JUMP had a short lead early pressed the pace inside the winner, broke down at the three eighths pole, and was pulled up. A Stewards' inquiry after the race looking at the second turn resulted in no change.
