Footnotes

JULIET'S KISS, unhurried early while three wide, closed quickly leaving the turn, responded smartly in the stretch, closed steadily and got up late. ROYAL LIVERPOOL was hustled early, stalked the pace, closed late turn, gained the lead briefly inside the furlong marker stretch then failed to stave off the winner in the final yards. CRICKET WICKET led quickly, set a reserved pace, quickened early turn, had command to the final furlong and gave way. ELUSIVE A. C. raced from well off the pace, closed late turn but hung in the stretch. ROWAN EXPRESS (GB) stalked the pace in hand along the rail, moved three-wide at the top of the stretch then flattened out. WHISPERTOASCREAM stalked from the second path, was roused upper stretch but lacked a response. TRUELY UNREAL, unhurried early on the second path, moved five-wide late turn then lacked a rally.
