BELIEVE IN MISSY led early, set the pace under pressure from DEPUTY CURES BLUES, shook clear at the 1/8 pole then just held under a drive. ROMAN ROMANCE stalked three-wide, was still in hand on the turn, responded to rousing at the top of the stretch and rallied gamely. KISSED BY A PRINCE, well back early, closed along the rail late turn then finished determinedly inside. SPANISH DECREE stalked from the rail, was set down midturn but hung in the stretch. DEPUTY CURES BLUES stumbled badly at the start but recovered quickly and pulled her way to the fore early on the backstretch, forced the issue and moved up closer outside the leader on the turn, launched an all out bid upper stretch but could not match strides and tired in the final furlong. PIERSIXER raced well off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn but hung in the stretch.
