STUNNING SPLIT raced in midpack, closed into the far turn, bid at the 1/4 pile, was headed at the top of the stretch, rebid a furlong out, dueled then drove clear and was taken in hand near the wire. JUSTIN'S TAPIT held a short lead on the backstretch, was under strong pressure through the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, rebid a furlong out but was outfinished. ANY GIVEN ROYAL stalked the pace, chased three and four-wide on the far turn then finished gamely. FEISTY ALBERT stalked the pace, forced the issue into the turn, chased to the stretch then finished all out between rivals. LIME DROP KID, off slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the far turn then finished gamely in vain. ROCKY ROMANO broke outward, raced in midpack, closed up and dueled from the inside on the far turn, gained the lead at the top of the stretch but gave way with a furlong to run. LOGAN STREET showed brief speed then pressed the pace, dropped back on the far turn, chased to the stretch then flattened out. SOLIDUS, off slowly, settled off the pace, chased hard three-wide on the far turn then tired in the stretch.
