MULL OVER showed brief speed then stalked the pacesetter on the turn, responded smartly and swept to the lead in the final furlong and held under steady handling. MAY FOURTEEN dueled on the backstretch, held a short lead on the turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch but was passed in the final furlong. MATTER OF TRUTH raced off the pace, closed late turn then rallied late outside. DONT THINK TWICE, off alertly, showed brief speed, chased five-wide late turn then evened out. ZIPCO showed brief speed on the backstretch, was hustled up close on the turn then evened out in the final furlong. PICO PIKE stalked the pace from the outside, chased late turn but evened out in the stretch. BOSS TWEED, prominent early inside rivals, dropped back at the turn, was hustled along midpack then evened out in the stretch. EUCLID AVENUE stalked the pace, chased on the turn then evened out in the stretch. DESTIND

TO PAY settled off the pace, gained midpack on the turn but had no serious closing response. FRIDAY NIGHT GUY raced off the pace, was hustled hard late turn but never reached contention. BIG RED DADDY, up close in hand, chased into the stretch then tired a 16th out. DANISH SPIRIT was taken back early, saved ground from off the pace but tired in the stretch.
