Footnotes

STORMY WAY set a pressured pace inside of rivals in the early going, dueled inside of DEMALOOTPHOTOSHOOT in the drive, put that one away in the final strides and held off SKY ALLIANCE under strong urging. The latter was unhurried early along the rail, closed the gap entering the stretch, but was blocked and had to alter course in mid stretch, came three wide in the final strides and got up for place. MARISA GO was bumped at the start and dropped back, saved ground on the turn, came between horses in the drive and closed willingly. DEMALOOTPHOTOSHOOT pressed the early pace between horses, dueled gamely outside of the winner in the stretch, then weakened in the final strides. GINGER GERRY was allowed to settle while saving ground, then finished with a mild rally along the rail. TOPSY MORNING (IRE) was hustled along and pressed the early pace three wide, then weakened in the drive. WYNYARD was bumped at the start and rank outside of rivals in the early going, continued five wide on the turn and finished evenly. DANZIGS SILVER was bumped badly at the start and dropped back to last, never rallied and was never a factor. ENDING WELL was hustled along four wide chasing the leaders in the early going, then tired in the drive and faded.
