**Footnotes**

EXTEND stalked the early pace outside of DEVASTATING, drew even on the turn and dueled to the wire, was a head behind for most of the drive, but surged in the final strides and prevailed under steady pressure. DEVASTATING was away alertly and set the early pace in hand just off the rail, held a short advantage in the drive before grudgingly giving way in the final strides. CATCH THE RING was taken back and unhurried early, swung wide on the turn and closed fast but late in the drive. RICH MIST was close up three wide and lacked a late response. CAFE DANCER stalked the early pace inside of rivals, but failed to respond on the turn and was never a factor. CASSIA was unhurried while off the rail, continued off the rail on the turn and never rallied.
