PIT ALLEY, rated early, closed up and stalked on the backstretch, angled in and bid late turn, vied briefly and shook clear at the top of the stretch then held under a drive. OYSTER CAT stalked the pace, bid midway of the backstretch, dueled to the turn and gained command, was engaged late turn, dueled to the top of the stretch, was headed and chased to the end. KINGS HIGHWAY raced midpack, closed on the turn, bid late turn, vied briefly then gave way five-wide at the top of the stretch. ICY JET led quickly, dueled from midbackstretch, was headed at the turn, gave way, chased to the stretch but lacked a rally. BRUNNERA stalked up close early, chased hard on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. CALM NIGHT was squeezed back entering the first turn, dropped off the pace then lacked a rally.
