Footnotes

ABSOLUTE HEAVEN stalked the pace, chased four and five-wide on the turn, bid at the 1/4 pole, dueled, then drove to the lead a 16th out and held under steady pressure. CLEARLY IN CHARGE stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide into the stretch, angled out in the final furlong and rallied outside. SKY HALO led early, dueled from midbackstretch then gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. EXECUTIVELY, in range, chased three to six-wide through the turn then evened out in deep stretch. JOVIAL JILL dueled from midway of the backstretch, vied on the second path through the turn then gave way in the final furlong. GETTING BOLD, rated off the pace, closed angling out eight-wide late turn but never reached contention. MOUNTAIN ECHO, rated off the pace, was hustled seven-wide late turn and tired in the late stages.
